

10 Ways to Raise \$800 or More for Camp Luther

1. Grab an apron and put on a breakfast or spaghetti dinner for your congregation. Ask for freewill donations or sell tickets. [Don't forget to ask the ladies of the congregation for permission to use the kitchen.☺]
2. Sell donuts or donut holes on Sunday morning at church. See if a bakery would donate the donuts.
3. Seek donations to camp from five key individuals in your congregation. Share with them the Camp Luther story and how reduction of the debt will advance the ministry of camp.
4. Recruit two or three campers to speak in front of the congregation and ask for a door offering for camp.
5. Have each golfer get \$20 pledges from ten different individuals.
6. Sell carnations or other flowers in your congregation on Mother's Day weekend.
7. Hold a father/son croquet tournament.
8. Ask your church council or voter's assembly for a special gift to Camp Luther.
9. Ask for support from your golf league or men's group.
10. Find out if your employer would match your contribution and/or the contributions of others.
