Our number one problem at camp is number two! We have a crappy problem and need your help! Help us keep camp flushing! There are lots of funny ways we could share this with you...and we have to have some fun with it; however, the reality is parts of our septic system need urgent updating.

There are some companies that do not want to service our equipment because it's age and condition bring up safety concerns. This project in total will cost Camp Luther over **\$100,000**. This includes needed updates on the following parts: hardware & software in our lift station, upper tank, and control panels.

We recognize that this is not the big & shiny project that everyone wants to give to, but it is currently the highest need here at camp. **If we don't have a working septic system we can't have people come to Camp Luther!**

We will be using this year's Giving Tuesday funds to kick-off this project and we are asking you to prayerfully consider supporting our septic system getting these necessary updates! We have two ways you can support this project through Giving Tuesday:

- **Pray:** For the longevity of camp, for God to provide the funds to complete this project, and for safety of those that will be working on this project.

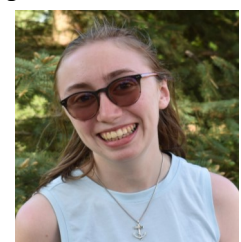

Annual Cottage Remodel: Crowsnest!

This cottage will remain a three-bedroom with the biggest change being the added lakeside screen porch. The layout will change with a new entry accessible ramp. Inside will be a complete remodel removing everything down to the stud walls. We will install all new electrical wiring & outlets as well as new plumbing pipes and fixtures. Spray foam will be important for this cottage for heating efficiency with new doors & windows. New flooring, light fixtures, counter tops, and custom cabinets will complete this remodel.

Renovations officially started during our Fall Workbee, October 20-22. Our staff and volunteers spent several hours demolishing the interior of the cottage, which is step one in any full remodel. Our team is extremely excited to continue working on this project through the winter to have the cottage ready for Family Campers!

New Camp Signs!



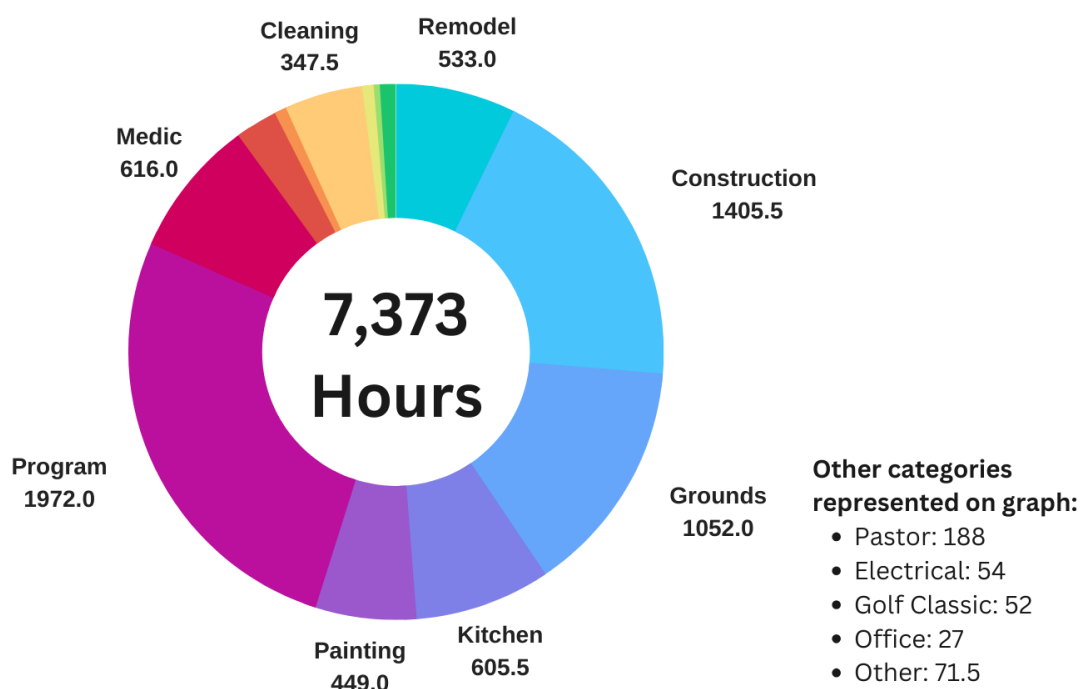

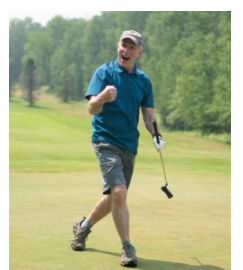

Summer 2023 was an exceptional year for our Every Kid to Camp Program/ EKTC. **We had 201 campers attend this summer through the EKTC Program!** Due to the support of our amazing donors we were able to utilize **\$89,195** so that campers could have their first full week camp experience with their registration fees covered.

The EKTC Program is not a needs based program, meaning the only qualification to receive an EKTC certificate is that it must be your first full week of summer camp at Camp Luther. For those that have financial challenges, we offer scholarships. We were able to offer **39** campers **\$8,557.50** in scholarships this summer. **Praise God!**

Supporting the Every Kid to Camp Program:

We rely on the faithful support of individuals and congregations to raise 75% of the annual contributions for the EKTC Fund! Our annual Golf Classic makes up the other 25% of the contributions. Due to your raving reviews of the Quiche that was served during Women's Retreat we decided to share our top secret recipe with you! ENJOY!

Quiche Lorraine

INGREDIENTS

Yield: 6 to 10 servings

- Pastry for a one-crust 9-inch pie
- 4 strips bacon
- 1 onion, thinly sliced
- 1 cup Gruyère or Swiss cheese, shredded
- ¼ cup grated Parmesan
- 4 eggs, lightly beaten
- 2 cups heavy cream or 1 cup each milk and cream
- ¼ teaspoon nutmeg
- ½ teaspoon salt
- ¼ teaspoon freshly ground pepper
- Tabasco sauce to taste

PREPARATION

- Heat the oven to 400°
- Line a nine-inch pie plate with the pastry. Build a rim with the pastry and flute it. This is essential for the amount of custard indicated in this recipe.
- Cover the bottom of the pastry with a round of parchment paper and add enough dried beans or peas to partly fill the shell. Bake 10 minutes.
- Reduce the oven heat to 375°. Remove the beans and parchment paper and set the pastry on a baking sheet.
- Cook the bacon until crisp. Drain, reserving one tablespoon of the fat remaining in the skillet. Cook the onion in the remaining fat until the onion is transparent.
- Combine the eggs, cream, nutmeg, salt, pepper and Tabasco sauce.
- Crumble the bacon and sprinkle the bacon, onion and cheeses over the inside of the partly baked pastry. Pour the custard mixture over the onion-cheese mixture.
- Bake the pie until a knife inserted one inch from the pastry edge comes out clean, about 50 minutes. Remove to a wire rack. Let stand 5 - 10 minutes before serving.
