## COUNSELOR/SPECIALTY ROLES

Camp Counselor (25): Camp Counselors are responsible for the 24-hour supervision of small groups of campers in a variety of different programs over the course of the summer. This role involves planning and leading daily activities, facilitating community development in their groups, leading faith formation times, and working closely with fellow summer staff members.

**Kitchen Lead (1):** The Kitchen Lead serves as an assistant to our full-time Food Service Manager and takes on responsibilities for staff supervision and kitchen oversight, especially when the Food Service Manager is absent.

**Kitchen Staff (3):** Kitchen Staff join an awesome team serving behind the scenes at camp. You'll work hard serving food and washing dishes, but also get to be a part of the fun that happens everyday at camp.

**Maintenance Staff (1):** Maintenance Staff serve behind the scenes doing mowing/yard work, trash pickup, painting, and a variety of other tasks, while also coordinating and working with awesome summer volunteers.

Office Staff (1): Office Staff work with our front office team to help manage logistics and cover responsibilities in the following areas: parent communication, camper registration and check-in, canteen, and lost and found items

Float Staff (2)\*: Float Staff serve as needed in a variety of work areas around camp, including lifeguarding, housekeeping, kitchen, canteen, and filling in for counselors during their time off.

Health Care Coordinator: The Heath Care PC oversees Camp Luther's summer health care policies and procedures. This role involves managing the intake and distribution of camper medications, caring for sick/injured campers, and coordinating with the volunteer medic of the week.

**Media Coordinator:** The Media PC oversees the social media presence of Camp Luther's summer programs, including serving as the summer photographer, under the supervision of the Retreats Program Manager.

## PROGRAM COORDINATOR ROLES

Youth Camp Program Coordinator (2): Youth Camp PCs oversee Camp Luther's residential youth camp programs and weekend programs. This role involves planning and leading a variety of program elements; coordinating logistical components such as camper housing assignments; and supervising/mentoring the summer counseling staff.

**Quest Program Coordinator\* (2):** The Quest PCs oversee the Quest and High School Week programs. This role involves developing and planning Quest curriculum and programming, coordinating program logistics, leading Quest sessions, and supervising summer staff assigned to these programs.

Impact Program Coordinator\* (2): The IMPACT PCs oversee Camp Luther's IMPACT program. This role involves developing and planning IMPACT curriculum and programming, coordinating program logistics including those involving the IMPACT adventure trip and service projects, leading IMPACT sessions, and supervising summer staff assigned to this program.

Junior Counselor Program Coordinator\*: The Junior Counselor PC oversees Camp Luther's JC program. This role involves intentional mentorship/supervision of the high school students who are a part of the JC program, including group building, faith formation, and leadership development.

Family Camp Program Coordinator: The Family Camp PC oversees Camp Luther's Family Camp program. This role involves planning and leading various program elements for Camp Luther's Family Camp program, helping the Director of Guest Services with a variety of administrative responsibilities, and supervising summer staff assigned to the Family Camp program.

Waterfront Coordinator\*: The Waterfront PC oversees Camp Luther's waterfront area. This role involves enforcing all waterfront policies and procedures, maintaining the highest safety standards for Camp Luther's swim area and boating activities, supervising/training lifeguards, and managing needed waterfront supplies and equipment.
