

Camp Luther - Village Use Policies

Your group leader is responsible for informing each member of your group about camp policies, and seeing that the policies are upheld.

Final Payment:

You will be asked to make your final payment when you check-in to camp. If possible, please pay via check. (It helps camp save money on credit card fees.) If paying by cash, we will not be able to provide change, so please pay with the exact amount.

Pets:

Pets are not allowed.

Quiet Hours:

Quiet hours are between 10:00pm and 7:00am daily.

Alcohol Policy:

Legal-aged guests may consume alcohol on the premises, but use is to be responsible and discrete. Camp Luther reserves the right to evict any guests.

Smoking Policy:

No smoking within 100 ft of buildings (this includes villages) or nearby underaged and/or non-smoking guests. Please pick up and dispose of all cigarette butts.

Waterfront:

There will be no lifeguard on duty. Persons swimming, canoeing, boating, floating, or using the docks do so at their own risk. Children and youth swimming must be actively supervised at all times by an adult 21 years of age or older. There is absolutely no swimming after dark.

Bathrooms & Drinking Fountains:

All village groups will be able to use a centrally located showerhouse (complete with lights/electricity, bathrooms, sinks, and showers). For all guests, the changing house next to the beach will be open to use as a public bathroom on main camp. Guests are also welcome to use the Community Center bathrooms and water bottle filler during open hours.

Housing Spaces:

Housing spaces are off-limits to other groups. You should not visit a village that you are not staying at or enter Retreat Center housing wings.

Laundry Facilities:

Laundry facilities are available on site. Please bring your own detergent.

Boats & Trailers:

You are allowed to bring your own boat and trailer, but please be aware we do not have dock space for you to use and there is limited parking space for trailers.

Village Parking:

You will be allowed to unload and load your vehicle at your village. Afterwards, you will be allowed to park one vehicle near your village. All other vehicles must be parked in the parking lot after unloading or loading.

Fireworks:

There are no fireworks allowed on Camp Luther property.

Campfires:

- Please restrict fire sizes. The wood provided is a generous donation from camp to you, cut and split by volunteers each year. Thank you for respecting their hard work and not overusing.
- If you'd like to collect your own firewood, only pick up dead or downed wood. Do not burn logs longer than the size of the firepit.
- PLEASE DO NOT BURN ANYTHING OTHER THAN WOOD IN THE FIREPITS! (Do not burn paper! Do not burn cans! Do not burn tin foil! Do not burn plastic!)

Village Housing Information

Please respect Camp Property. Any damages may be added to your invoice.

Kitchen Equipment

- Please bring your own dishes and cooking equipment; they will not be provided. Camp Luther will have Pudgie Pie Irons, Skewers, Portable Grates, and Large Metal Washbins available to check-out but all other dishes and utensils are your responsibility.
- Bags of ice will be available to purchase at camp for a small fee.

Dishwashing:

- Please thoroughly scrape and throw away all food scraps in the garbage before washing dishes. (BEARS ARE NOT YOUR FRIENDS)
- Please do NOT burn food scraps or any trash.

Garbage:

- Each village is provided with a secure trash container.
- Please do NOT burn any trash.
- Please bring your trash to the dumpster before checking out on Sunday.

Bathrooms/Showers:

- All villages will be able to use a centrally located showerhouse (complete with lights/electricity, bathrooms, sinks, and showers) that will be shared by all village campers.
